PURCHASE ORDER ATTACHMENT

First Article Review (FAR)

FIRST ARTICLE REVIEW (FAR): The first article(s) of each item (or each designated item if specific items are designated in the body of this Purchase Order) will be subject to an FAR by a representative of RSL and/or RSL's customer at the Seller's plant. The Seller shall notify the RSL Procurement Representative at least five (5) days in advance of the date when the first articles of each item are ready for FAR. RSL will advise the sample size of items for inspection and test, at random from the first articles produced. At the time of inspection and test, Seller shall provide the RSL representative with verifiable quality evidence to assure that the first articles meet the requirements of this Purchase Order, and provide adequate inspection and test equipment, necessary space and facilities including assembly and disassembly assistance for the performance of such inspection/review and test.

The following Information should be made available at the time of the FAR.

RSL PO.including all documents flowed down.
Serial Numbers of parts (Where applicable)
Compliance Prompt Sheet (Where applicable)
CoC's of material used in the construction as per Drawing / Specification
Current ECN's, Queries as part of the PO
Training status of personnel used in the manufacturing process.
Full Dimensional report (All drawing/ Spec dimensions)
All Open NC's (Internal & External) applicable to the product being manufactured, or the process being used.

FACILITIES INSPECTION: At the time sample items are subjected to inspection and test, the RSL representative and/or RSL's customer shall also be entitled to inspect Seller's production equipment and operations, including jigs, fixtures, measuring and testing equipment and process control procedures which were used to produce the samples subjected to inspection and test and which will be used in subsequent manufacturing production runs.

PCB SECTION REPORT: This will be supplied with every shipment of PCB's.

A Complete FAR will/may be required if there is a/an...(RSL shall decide when notified what is required. Supplier shall notify RSL Buyer prior to making any changes.)

- 1 INTERRUPTION OF PRODUCTION:** A complete FAI/T will be required prior to shipment of hardware if 12 months or more has elapsed since the last production item was produced.
- 2 CHANGE OF FACILITY / PROCESSING EQUIPMENT:** A change in or to tools, test equipment, measuring or aligning fixtures, processing tanks or equipment, machinery, machine set-ups, other plant manufacturing equipment, etc., used to manufacture, process, assemble, inspect and / or test the item.
- 3 CHANGE TO PROCEDURES:** A change in or to the methods, procedures, planning and / or sequencing used in or applicable to the manufacturing, processing, assembly, inspection and / or test of an item.
- 4 CHANGE OF LOCATION:** A change in location of the site where some or all of the work on items is being performed. It may be as little as moving an assembly fixture. It may not involve a change in facilities, procedures, personnel and / or processing sources.
- 5 CHANGE IN SOURCE OF PROCESSING:** Such changes may be from an outside processing source to within the supplier's facility, from within the supplier's facility to an outside processing source, or from one outside processing source to another.

6 OTHER OBLIGATIONS: Neither acceptance of FAR samples nor RSL's authorisation to proceed with the manufacturing production run shall constitute an acceptance of any subsequent items from any obligation of the Seller to perform strictly in accordance with the provisions of this Purchase Order requirements. Any subsequent significant changes to Process or Facility location must be reported to the RSL Procurement representative and may result in a repeat FAR.

PRODUCTION: The Seller shall institute corrective action to ensure that discrepancies discovered during the FAR do not recur in the manufacturing and test of the Production Articles. The Seller shall not commence production of units beyond the first articles until RSL has completed its FAR operations as outlined above in this Attachment and has thereafter authorised the Seller in writing to proceed with the manufacture of a production run.

LOCATION: RSL may at its sole discretion elect to conduct its FAR at a location other than Seller's plant, in which case it will direct the Seller to ship the first articles, in accordance with the shipping instructions as part of this Purchase Order. Such direction shall not be construed as a waiver of RSL's right to inspect and test or RSL's right to withhold authorisation to proceed with the manufacturing production run.
